

TRUSTEE ELECTIONS **Identification Needed to Vote**

All voters must establish their identity for the official voters list by providing:

- An official document issued by a federal, provincial or municipal government that includes, voter's name, address, and photograph (driver's license, passport etc.); or
- At least two other documents that provide evidence of the person.

At the voting locations, voters will be asked to provide one piece of photo identification that contains their name and address, OR two other pieces of identification, one of which must contain their address.

Other suitable identification documents include:

- Manitoba Health Services Commission card
- Manitoba Health card
- Manitoba Blue Cross card
- A blank personalized cheque
- A credit card statement
- An Old Age Pension/Security card
- An income tax Assessment statement
- A utility bill

Please remember that passports and Birth Certificates DO NOT provide proof of current address, but they can be used in conjunction with ID displaying current address.
